

Research Fellowship for URGE-Collegio Carlo Alberto

Academic Year 2009-2010

The Collegio Carlo Alberto of Moncalieri (Turin), Italy (www.carloalberto.org) offers a Research Fellowship for the academic year 2009-2010. The candidate will carry out her/his research in the area of Political Studies (with a preference given to candidates whose research focuses on European Affairs) and will be affiliated with URGE, the research unit of the Collegio conducting research in this area (www.urge.it).

Eligibility

Eligible candidates must have a doctorate in political or social sciences awarded not earlier than 2006, or must have defended their dissertations by the time of the start of the fellowship (September 1, 2009).

Terms

The research fellowship is awarded for one year, on a full-time basis. The gross salary is 36.000 euro per year. The Collegio will also reimburse a round-trip economy ticket (or train ticket) from the place of residence of the candidate.

The fellowship may be renewed for one additional year by mutual agreement.

If s/he so wishes, the fellow has the opportunity of spending the additional year (2010/11) at the Bremen International Graduate School of Social Sciences (BIGSSS) in Germany, run by the University of Bremen and the Jacobs University (www.bigsss-bremen.de) (final acceptance to the BIGSSS Post-doc program subject to approval).

How to Apply

Applications must be sent through the Collegio's web site at

and must include a CV with a list of publications, as well as a research proposal (4-8 pages).

Deadline

The applications must be received by **May 31, 2009**.

Selection Process

The selection committee will contact short-listed candidates no later than June 10, 2009 and invite them for interviews at the Collegio in late June and early July. The Collegio is under no obligation to award the research fellowship if the applications received are considered not suitable.
