This journal is intended to contribute to the development of international economics. Any author, either a member or non-member of this society, may submit manuscripts. The Committee of Publication of this society may also invite authors to submit their manuscripts.

Guide for Authors*

1. Manuscripts, including invited ones, must be in English and must be unpublished work.
2. Manuscripts should be typewritten and should be submitted either in hard copy or electronically. Hard-copy submissions should be sent in quadruplicate and electronic submissions should be sent in PDF format.
3. Manuscripts should be sent to the headquarter office of *The Japan Society of International Economics*. The information on the headquarter office may be found at <http://wwwsoc.nii.ac.jp/jsie/>.
4. Manuscripts should be double-spaced on A4 paper and should be no longer than 35 pages with figures and tables included. An English abstract of not more than 100 words should be attached.
5. The author should attach the following information to manuscripts:
Name(s); corresponding address; phone and fax numbers, e-mail address;
institutional affiliation(s); department; location; phone and fax numbers.
6. Submitted manuscripts will not be returned to the author if accepted or not accepted.
7. The accepted manuscripts should be sent to the editor-in-chief with electronic files on a floppy disk. The disk will not be returned to the author.
