BACKGROUND

The International Society for Mushroom Science Congress (ISMSC) is a regular forum for the world's mushroom researchers to exchange research results and development activities across all segments of the mushroom industry and promote international communication and cooperation. Being the top international conference for the mushroom research community and the industry at large, the previous seventeen ISMSCs have been held in different countries since being launched in 1950.

The 18th ISMSC will be held in Beijing, P.R. China on August 26-30, 2012. The main purpose of this Congress is to promote the development of the edible mushroom industry as well as to present the latest development of the edible mushroom industry in China. In addition to the scientific exchange, new varieties, new products, new technologies and latest publications will be showcased.
