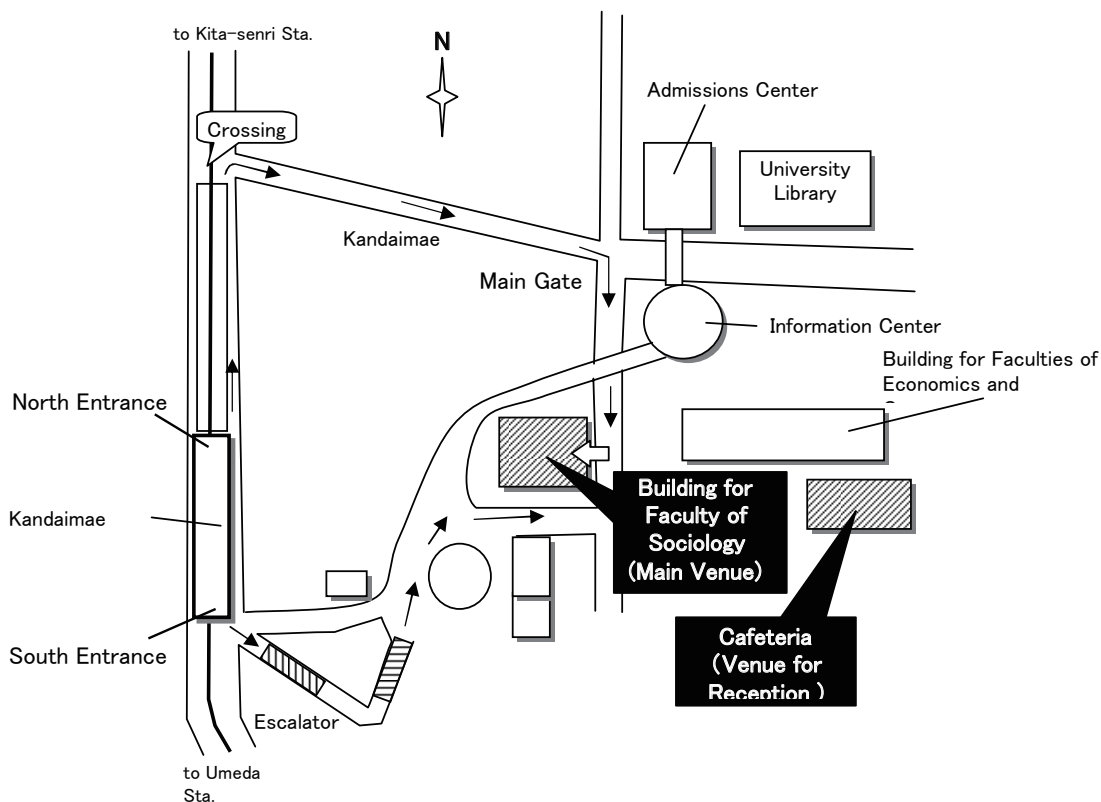
From Kansai International Airport:

From Itami Airport:

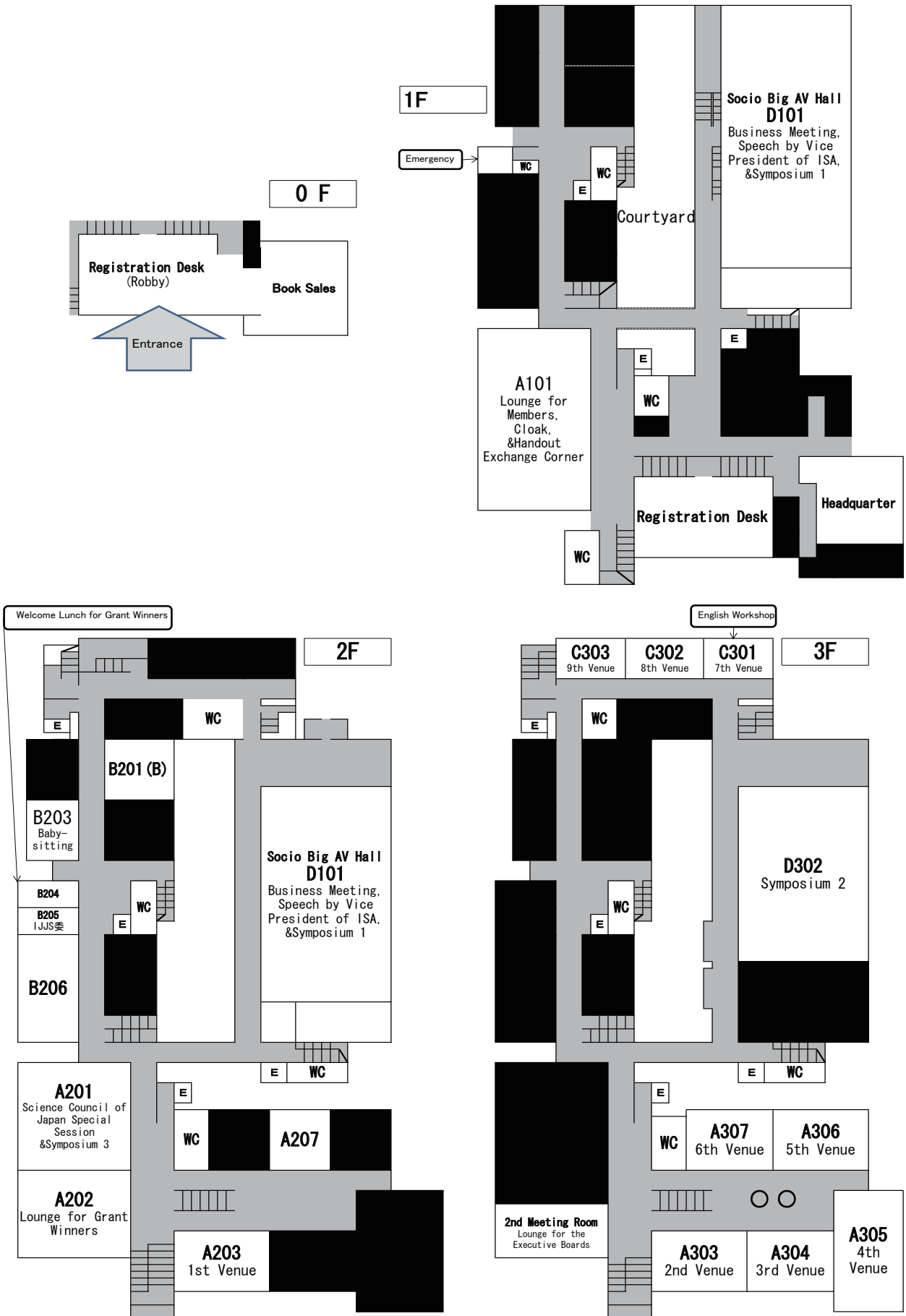

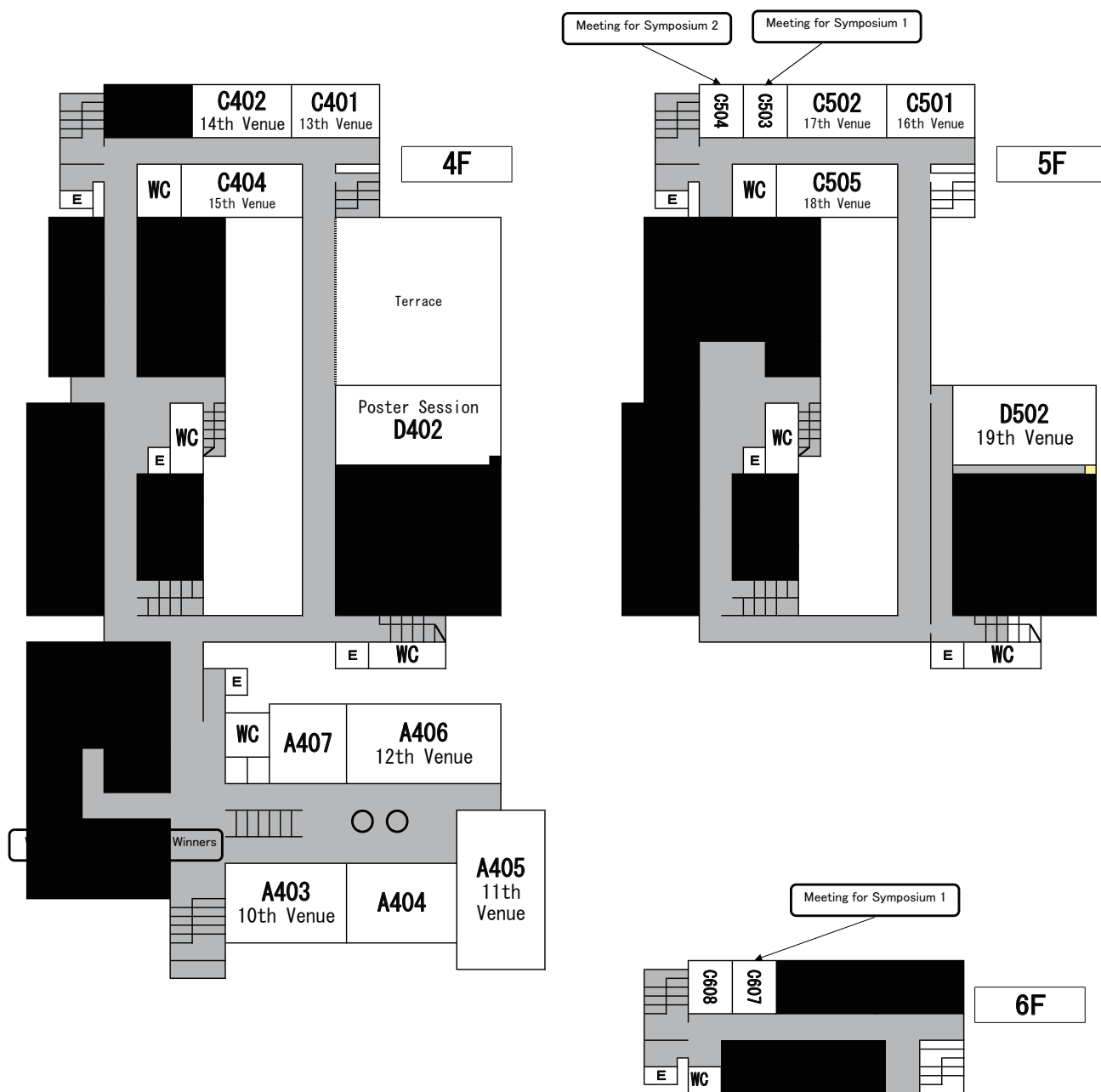
The Map of Senriyama Campus, Kansai University
